

1983. So, with that, there's no corresponding A bill do to it and I would ask for your adoption of this. We need to do this and the reason it's special ordered is that we need to get this accomplished before they move into the university system in July of 1991.

**PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING**

**PRESIDENT MOUL:** Thank you, Senator Kristensen. I'll now recognize senators in the following order: Senator Moore, Bernard-Stevens, and Cudaback. Senator Moore.

**SENATOR MOORE:** Well, Madam President, I hesitate to correct Senator Kristensen, but one small item in the bill that does simply...does not cost any money but does change the authority. If you look on page 2065 of the amendment, it actually...in the old 410 that we passed '83 it allowed for basically three different projects to be...from the State College Buildings Renovation and Land Acquisition Fund. We are now adding a fourth one to that and also we are raising the authority from 350 to 370, and so that is the only dollar impact. The money is there. It does not take additional state dollars to do this, but it does change the authority slightly from 350 to 370, and so, with that addition, I'd simply ask for adoption of the amendment.

**PRESIDENT MOUL:** Thank you, Senator Moore. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

**SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS:** Thank you, Madam Chairman, and again I would urge the body for the adoption of the amendment. It is through the cooperation of the University of Nebraska and the University at Kearney, also the State College Board that has all these groups working together to make as smooth a transition as possible. This is something that should happen. It's going to happen with the adoption of this amendment. It certainly is something that the body can do with a free feeling that we're not appropriating any more tax money. Something that simply needs to be done and I urge the adoption of the amendment.
