

Conway amendment to the amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Conway's first technical amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Conway would move to amend the committee amendments. I now have your AM2140, Senator. (See AM2140 as found on page 2505 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CONWAY: Okay.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. Before we move into that, if I could please, most of you have a packet on your desk that was passed out on Friday which shows the maps and has the statistics for each one of those maps for all the bills that we'll be dealing with today. If you don't have such a map on your desk and available to you, I have extras over here on the corner of my desk and I'd appreciate if you'd come and get one. Those of you who already have one, they are the same thing. Just a second, please. Also, there is a...the statistics for the Supreme Court, as they were...was not included in the packet before, also we'll pass those out for everyone so that you can add those to the packet. They weren't in the packet that went out on Friday. Okay, going on to the amendment, 2140 I believe is what we're on now. Is that right, Mr. Clerk? I'm sorry. AM2140? AM2140 is another amendment that amends the committee amendment. This one deals and adds a Section 3. Since there...under the Public Service Commission situation, two current Public Service Commissioners are in the same district. It simply describes that the Public Service Commissioner representing Public Service Commission District 3 on the effective date of this act shall represent the new Public Service Commission District 3 as established by the legislative bill for the balance of his or her term. So, basically, that gives term protection to that Public Service Commissioner if they so choose to carry out their existing term. As many of you may note, the Public Service Commission is the only one that does not have term protection. All of the others do. But, because it did not have term protection, this is an amendment to
