

SENATOR CONWAY: Not really. I can try and track you through. If you look at the top of District 5, Knox County, like I say, was not split before. Then down at the bottom where the southern, or excuse me, the east-southeastern corner of District 5, if you're there, those four, Phelps, Kearney, Harlan and Franklin, were added to the 5th, okay, where they were notched out before. Also, in District 4, Platte and Colfax are new to District 4. They weren't there before. Then, if you look at District 1, before you had literally all of Sarpy, Cass, Otoe and Lancaster. Now it's Lancaster, Otoe, Cass, Sarpy, but with a corner out of Sarpy up in the Plattsmouth area, will now go into the 2nd District, but that...and then a different line in Douglas County, per se, because they had to trim out some of the population there that goes out into the 3rd. So it's really not a very drastic alternation from the previous plan.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Does anyone else wish to address the committee amendments? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Conway? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Conway, would you like to open on the bill itself?

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. LB 618, the Public Service Commission districts as now amended by the committee amendments basically is the bill. Again, it was a readjustment to very close tolerances relative to the population requirements. Following the public hearing and any discussion taken during the Public Service Commission request, the committee then adopted this plan with that balance and forwarded it to the committee, which is now the committee amendments, which is now the bill. So I simply offer that as it's mapped out and showing with those committee...amendments to the committee amendments that were simply of a technical nature. So I offer that for the body to advance to hopefully Select File.
