

the amendment and, again, we're dealing with State Board of Education now, which we're using, since both the Board of Regents and the State Board of Education have eight members, we are using, as we have in the past, exactly the same districts in terms of their mapping configurations. The amendment to this amendment then includes a situation where in the committee amendment that we'll be dealing with here shortly it was identified inappropriately in terms of the numbering of the districts, and so what the amendments to LB 619 do is, and reads, the members representing Districts 6 and 7 on the effective date of this act shall thereafter represent District 7 and 6. They were turned around on the original drafting and so therefore they're placed back in the proper area. It also then goes on to describe that the person serving in District 5, as it's established under the new plan, will have the right to serve out the balance of his or her term. Again, here is a situation where we do have two people in the same district, District 7. We have one member who hails from Hall County and another one from Sherman County and so, therefore, they would both be in District 7, but it does give term protection out through the rest of their term. They were both just elected last November so it gives both of them term protection and then a decision will be made at that time. So that basically is or is the amendment to the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the Conway amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Amendment is adopted. Senator Conway, would you like to address the committee amendments?

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. The State Board of Education districts we're working on now, LB 619, is again the mapping and the description is identical to the board of regents that we just adopted. The only real difference now between the two is that, different than the board of regents, the State Board of Education now has two of their current incumbents in District 7 and currently Hall County is in District 5 and so that is the separation currently. But with the amendment to the amendment we just adopted, we have given
