

representative, I don't think an urban representative in the State of Nebraska can preclude his interest in agriculture, period, by virtue of the very process, the food processing activity, as we find the nature of Nebraska. Even though people live in Omaha, most of them still have at least one foot still back on the farm, and have much of the farm interest and the general agricultural economy at heart and the like. I really don't think that that is going to cause the Douglas, Sarpy, if that is all that is left, basically, member to disregard the agricultural interest. By the same token, the residents of Burt and Washington County have a great deal in common in terms of community interest with the rest of the First Congressional District in agricultural interest and ought to find a very positive representation in that area. What I would like to ask Senator Robinson is that since he did not pass out the stats, and as the marshal of this operation, I would like to see the statistics to make sure that they balance relative to the proposal, so I guess I would ask him at this time, do you have the stats, and would you like to share those with us?

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Sure. These were worked out. My aide was...aide in your office, and in the Third Congressional District, it is a minus 30. It is a deviation. The percentage is .017 percent, exactly the same as your plan, Senator Conway. In the First, plus 364, your plan, or excuse me, my plan is .069 percent. Your plan is .66 percent. In the Second Congressional District, there is a plus 364. Your plan is .83 percent. My plan is .069 percent, so they are very close, and within the limits, as I have been told.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Robinson. What I would also like to remind the body is we are probably approaching a vote and voting...approaching the noon hour. Since this is an amendment to an amendment, those of you who are simply not engaged or waiting for another amendment to come up, it will not behoove you to not vote and that a simple majority will attach this, that Senator Robinson's plan is a simple majority on an amendment to the amendment on General File. So I would suggest those who are looking to other plans to be very proactive in their votes in casting red votes against the Senator Robinson plan.
