CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please be seated and please check in. Senator Beyer and Senator Wickersham, would you please check in. Senator Ashford, please check in. We're looking for Senator Robak. The house is under call and we are looking for Senator Robak. Senator Schimek, we cannot locate Senator Robak, do you want to proceed? Okay, we'll proceed with roll call vote on the Conway amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2518-19 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 18 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Conway amendment is adopted. I will raise the call.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay, Senator Conway, do you wish to open on the committee amendments?
