

numbers haven't been run yet but are going to be attempts and so, like I said, I'm a bit surprised there weren't even more to discuss here on General File in order to look forward to that. I think the proper choice of the body, short of throwing in the towel on the legislative races and going for a special session, would be to advance what we have in front of us, in terms of the committee amendments, on to Select File and look for the amendments on Select File since they're not filed today; that to stall the bill at this point in time simply would probably, by virtue of the timing we have left in the session, lead to an automatic special session, which I don't think is necessary. But we can assume for those people who have a vision of something different than what is on the table and what is the committee amendments, that to support the bill at this point and bring forth further opportunities at Select File for those amendments. So I guess I'd urge the body to adopt the committee amendments to LB 614 at this time.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. We will now vote on the committee amendments to LB 614. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the committee amendments? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 3 nays on the adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Committee amendments are adopted. Is there anyone who wishes to speak to the bill itself? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Conway?

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. The committee amendments now is the bill and, as I mentioned before as we're closing on the committee amendments themselves that, again, there will be opportunities for additional visions for the legislative redistricting come Select File, but I think it's imperative, by virtue of the timing and the process that we're living under right now, to go ahead and advance 614 to E & R Initial so that it can be...have its place in the timing patterns between now and sine die on June 5th.
