SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any other discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Wickersham, do you wish to close? Waives closing. We will now vote on the amendment by Senator Wickersham. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Anyone wishing to discuss the advancement of the bill? Senator Chambers has asked for a roll call vote on the advancement. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2546-47 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill does not advance. We will proceed to the next item of business, LB 320.

CLERK: Mr. President, 320, I have E & R amendments pending, first of all.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move for the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 320.

SPEAKER BAACK: You have heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Hall. Senator, I have your AM1492. That is found on page 1850 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.
