SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Wesely, I did not realize that. Now let's discuss does the bill contain more than one subject? In your opinion, does it contain more than one subject, Senator Wesely?

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. Having previously described the amendment and the virtue that it has, in addition, the fact it will save us some money for the reprinting, I would urge its adoption at this time.
