just pull from the amendment in front of us the appropriation aspect of the bill that was incorporated in LB 829A that we advanced over to Select File this morning. And, Mr. Clerk, if we could go to that amendment right now, it probably would be...

PRESIDENT MOUL: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Hall would move to amend the amendment by striking Sections 29 and 30 thereof. (The Hall amendment appears on page 2603 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President. Again, this amendment to the amendment is the last correction, I think, to this proposal. It just deals with striking the appropriation section that was in the amendment because it currently sits in LB 829, which is over on E & R Initial. And I would urge adoption of this amendment and then come back to the technical amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. I rise in support of Senator Hall's amendment to the amendment. As he indicated, the technical amendment, initially, included appropriations language that was more appropriately inserted in LB 829A, when we decided to draft and introduce an A bill, which was just yesterday. Obviously, Senator Warner's amendment was worked up before that time, and we now have a separate bill that deals with the appropriation, itself, which is both the money that goes to political subdivisions, and the money that goes to the Department of Revenue to operate the program that is being established on the surcharge tax. Those are issues that ought to be dealt with in LB 829A. We advanced that this morning. At this point, I would urge you to adopt the amendment to the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Will. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak to the Hall amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Hall? Closing is waived. We will now vote on the Hall amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
