

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Crosby. Senator Wehrbein.

**SENATOR WEHRBEIN:** Yes, Mr. Speaker and members, I guess I want to ask some questions, and it is based maybe on the record, for the record. I support this but I was thinking, what will be the effective deadline in your mind, April 1st or April 20th?

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Senator Smith.

**SENATOR SMITH:** The deadline is April, the 1st. What this would do is allow the commissioners or the supervisors to make a determination up to the 20th, if they interpret this as a hardship case, which is legitimate.

**SENATOR WEHRBEIN:** Will that be publicized is my point?

**SENATOR SMITH:** Do you mean whether or not that they have until the 20th?

**SENATOR WEHRBEIN:** I mean...

**SENATOR SMITH:** I don't think that they are planning to publicize it. You would still publish your regular date, which as I have a copy in my paper here, my paper from last year, a little notice in the paper about the date, which is April 1st.

**SENATOR WEHRBEIN:** I have the same thing with, not so much...with property, or filing for appeals, and some say May 1st, and the listing says 30 days from April 1st, and some allow this in Douglas County, and Cass County didn't in another area. But so often when you set a date, it becomes then that it be delinquent...what am I looking for...the extension becomes the deadline instead of the first date and that is what I would be concerned here from a practical matter. It still ought to be April 1st, and it shouldn't say, you know, but practically, it is April 20th, so people will wait until the 19th, and then they will have a hardship on the 20th, and then we will have to extend it beyond that. So I would want to be sure that our intent is still make it April 1st, and that if, in case of a hardship, it could be extended to the 20th, but I want to be sure April 20th does, in effect, become the date because I just, I mean I haven't had no input from this, but I just know what happens practically speaking, and it is not your intent to change that effective date...
