SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Chizek.

SENATOR CHIZEK: I want to withdraw that.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move for the advancement of LB 320 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You have heard the motion to advance LB 320. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. We will go to LB 754.

CLERK: Mr. President, 754 again was discussed on Tuesday. Senator Johnson had an amendment pending, AM2056. I have a note that Senator Johnson wants to withdraw that, but Senator Wehrbein had an amendment pending to 2056, Senator, your AM2160.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, or Mr. Clerk, I would like to withdraw that please.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: All right, Senator. Then Senator Johnson, you want to withdraw 2056, and offer 2188, is that correct, Senator?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Yes, sir.

CLERK: Okay. (See pages 2661-67 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Any objection? No objection, so ordered. Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members, I don't wish this debate to get rather lengthy so I've distributed for you a copy of the amendment as well as an explanation of the amendment, recognizing the changes that this amendment will bring to the law, and also if you look in parenthesis, you will see what the current law is.
