

in life is to get the ethanol fund depleted, I agree with you, Senator Schmit, to get ethanol produced. But if you want that production credit level at 20 cents, then we need to, along with that, reimplement the checkoff on the corn farmers in the State of Nebraska because the production credit at 20 cents on present activity alone will deplete the fund by '95, and if you have additional activity any sooner than that or after that, you're going to need a checkoff of one or two cents on every bushel of corn sold in the State of Nebraska. Now the way the bill is now, I don't think...Senator Schmit has some additional amendments that I may be supporting, to tell you the truth, but for the time being if you adopt my amendment with...now that Senator Schrock's amendment is also adopted, you have three things in the bill. You have the oxygenated fuel issue put to rest for this year. You'll have the investment...the...the investment credit aspect of the bill chipped out of it, and if you do this, you will decrease some 20 cents to 10 cents of production credit and guaran...well, not guarantee but certainly have a much better chance of the ethanol fund continuing to be able to be used to attract new industry, new ethanol industry to the State of Nebraska which is certainly my goal and I think many others all along. With that, I simply ask for adoption of the amendment and will reiterate you're talking about a total of \$2 million just in the next two years if you do not adopt this amendment.
