

SENATOR CONWAY: One minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: But that is also up to the body. I want to say again that over the past years that we have had the credit at the gasoline pump, there have been times when we have noted that the price of ethanol enriched fuel was, in fact, higher than the price of unleaded fuel, not a proper use of the fund, I think we know. This might be a time and a place to take a second look at that and I'm willing to do so.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Schmit. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a priority motion. Senator Coordsen would move to bracket LB 754 until June 3, 1991.

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I offer this motion not to take anything away from this debate but there are a number of other issues that need to be addressed yet today on Select File. I believe if we would continue this discussion on Monday, it would still give us time enough to pass on Select File, lay the bill over and pass the bill in some form or the other on Wednesday. So, with that, I would urge the adoption of the bracket motion.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, Mr. President, I really wouldn't object to the bracket motion, Senator, if it were just a little bit later. I would like to ask if Senator Warner has an amendment up there, is it possible we could address the Warner amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Then, Senator Schmit, is there going to be another amendment on the Warner amendment, you know, I mean whatever happens, the discussion is getting further...fairly elongated. I understand your particular position but I feel that at this point in time maybe we ought to try the bracket motion.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, I would just, at this time, suggest that I would not support the motion to bracket at this time. I would...I understand the concern but I would just like to say that we have spent a lot of time on other issues and I think
