

injuries to the person or property and should bear no liability for normal practices conducted upon their land in the production of agricultural products, be that plant or animal. So, therefore, I would support the Wickersham amendment to LB 714. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Next, an amendment to the Wickersham amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman would move to amend. (See FA186 as found on page 2688 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR HABERMAN: Explain it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I have had some concerns about the people using these trails and I've talked to the Game and Parks people and I've been thinking about during hunting season there's going to be pheasants, quails, deer, what have you around these trails because they're going to be built for animal shelters, which there's nothing wrong with that because when people are on these trails they want to see animals and they're going to see them, and the shrubbery and the food and everything that are on these trails are going to attract game animals. So let's take that a step further and say, what's going to happen during hunting season? Well, during hunting season the people are going to be using these trails and there's going to be hunters and they're going to see the game, go into the shrubbery and trees and et cetera by the trails and they're going to go after the game. Now they're not deliberately going to shoot anybody or shoot at anyone, but it's going to be awfully hard to see that somebody possibly isn't or doesn't get shot if they're using the trail during hunting season. So the amendment, the amendment holds the hunter harmless if he should accidentally injure somebody during hunting season. That's what the amendment does. I would ask for your adoption to this amendment to the Wickersham amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler, did you wish to address the Haberman amendment?
