SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR SMITH: ...a totally different turn from what its original intent was. I am going to oppose this amendment at this time although perhaps I should support your amendment to the amendment because it does at least define what you're trying to do here as far as the hookup to the central computer. But the amendment itself I definitely am in opposition to and I would ask other people to keep that in mind as they listen to the debate on this issue. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Smith.

SENATOR HALL: Point of order.

SENATOR HALL: Just a point of order, Mr. Speaker, just for purposes of clarification. This amendment that is to an amendment is not the amendment that is hand drafted. I am amending that with 1978 from the bill drafters and the amendment that further clarifies 1978 with the addition of Section (e) has yet to come before us.
