PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. We will now vote on the Moore amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Moore amendment? Have you all voted?

SENATOR MOORE: Madam, given the vote I'd ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We've had a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Will the senators please be seated and please record their presence. All unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and please check in. The house is under call. Senator Rogers, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Lamb, please check in. Senator Schmit, Senator Pirsch, please check in. Senator Ashford, please check in. Senator Labedz, please check in. And, Senator Pirsch, please check in. We will proceed with a roll call vote in reverse order.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See pages 2697-98 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 17 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment fails. I will raise the call. Is there anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Does anyone wish to address the bill itself? Seeing none, would you like to close, Senator Hall?

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I'd just move advancement of LB 795 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 795. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 795 is advanced. We'll proceed with LB 91.

CLERK: Madam President, I have E & R amendments, first of all.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.
