SENATOR NELSON: With your amendment we just adopted, wasn't that 20 million?

SENATOR WITHEM: No, there's an amendment on General File, I believe that...

SENATOR NELSON: On General File that we brought it down to 15.

SENATOR WITHEM: ...maybe you ought to address it to Senator Lynch, it's his bill, but my understanding an amendment on General File to reduce the appropriation from 20 million dollars to 15 million dollars and that's where the bill now stands.

SENATOR NELSON: All right. When I skimmed through your amendment I saw the 20 million dollar figure, I thought, in there. Maybe it was printed before that time, see.

SENATOR WITHEM: I had an additional five million, when and if that gets appropriated, dealing with performance based.
