CLERK: Mr. President, I now have Senator Hefner's amendment that was passed over earlier Senator. Pull that? I have nothing further...

SENATOR LYNCH: I would respectfully ask for the support of the body, that you support 91A.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 91A, all those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Items for the record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, amendments to be printed to LB 703A by Senator Wesely and 614 by Senators Robak, Dierks, and Rogers. (See pages 2699-2700 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have.

SPEAKER BAACK: Before I entertain a motion to adjourn, I will kind of give you an idea of my plans for tomorrow. I think that we will not work through the noon hour.
