SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. The amendment, AM2158 I believe, 2158 is simply a technical amendment that we found. When dividing some streets in Omaha, we picked up a street that wasn't continuous and so, therefore, a new description had to be crafted in order to do that, and so it strikes the 158th Street Circle reference, which was the improper reference, and talks about a point on an east-west lane extending from a point halfway between Woolworth Avenue and Pine Street. A technical amendment but when you converted the line on the map into the computer we found out that that was not a continuous. It was actually a precinct line and not a street all the way through, so it's simply a technical amendment to describe it that way.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Conway? Seeing none, we will vote on the amendment by Senator Conway. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Conway's amendment.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 617 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 617. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 619.

CLERK: Mr. President, 619, Senator, I have E & R amendments pending.
