SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, members, I rise in support. Just a brief glance at the amendment, and placing it into the Warner amendment, which it amends, I don't see where it changes any of the intent of the proposal. And just for clarification sake, Senator Warner, would you respond to a question?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Warner, would you respond to a question, please.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Warner, the...you amend AM2240, correct, your proposal?

SENATOR WARNER: Correct.

SENATOR HALL: So it would be part of that separate ballot issue that dealt...

SENATOR HALL: Okay, thank you very much.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Anyone else wishing to discuss the amendment by Senator Warner? Seeing no one, Senator Warner, did you wish to close? Waives closing.
