

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I respectfully ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
