SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Smith asks for a call of the house and a roll call vote. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Senators, please return to the Chamber and check in. Clerk, record, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President. to go under call.

SENATOR LANDIS: We are under call. Please return to the Chamber and please check in. Senator Labedz, please check in. Senators Rasmussen, Peterson, and Dierks. Senator Beyer. We are looking for Senators Bernard-Stevens, Rasmussen and Beyer. Senator Smith, may we begin. Thank you. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2745 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR LANDIS: The amendment fails. We will be back to the Hall amendment. Mr. Clerk, is there another amendment?

CLERK: There is, Mr. President. Senator Withem and Rasmussen would move to amend.

SENATOR LANDIS: Raise the call. Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Before I get into that, could I ask Senator Moore a question?

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Moore, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR WITHEM: Senator Moore, I understand you have the next amendment up which...excuse me, may I please ask Senator Moore a question, Mr. Chairman.

SENATOR LANDIS: We'll find out. Senator Moore, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, I will yield to a question. The answer to Senator Withem's question is yes.

SENATOR WITHEM: Okay, Mr. Chair, is it appropriate now to ask my question of Senator Moore?

SENATOR LANDIS: It is now appropriate.
