SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, I guess I would ask for a call of the house and take call in votes.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. Would senators please be seated and please check in. The house is under call and we are accepting call in votes on the Beutler amendment.

CLERK: Senator Horgan voting yes. Senator Labeledz voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Lynch, Senator Nelson, Senator Byars, would you please check in. Senator Conway, please check in.

CLERK: Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Rod Johnson voting no.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Lamb, please check in. Still looking for Senator Lamb and Senator Rasmussen. We're accepting call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Nelson voting yes. Senator Smith voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. I will raise the call. Is there anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. (Chambers amendment appears on page 2749 of the Legislative Journal.)
