SENATOR WESELY: Yes, if I could, just for the record.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: There was a...Mr. Speaker, members, there was an error made. Fiscal Office amendment indicated the wrong fund. This would have clarified that, but I understand that, Senator Moore, we can work out that. It's just a technical glitch and I'll give some time to Senator Moore if he wants, but I don't think there's any problem here. We can go ahead and read the bill, but maybe Senator Moore wants to comment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: No, I would concur with Senator Wesely. If this was May 3rd instead of June 3rd, we would do it. Since it's June 3rd, it's something that is technical in nature and can be dealt with.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is withdrawn. You may read the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 703A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 703A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2765 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 703A passes. We'll now go to LB 256.

CLERK: (Read LB 256 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 256 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2766 of the Legislative
