

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam President, and members, I also rise to support this amendment. It's something that Senator Ashford and myself worked out. SENATOR MOORE: ...the language found on page 2456 of the Journal which talks about the State Patrol shall make all reasonable efforts to updating the computerized criminal history, your intent there is that they continue doing what they're doing at a rate they're now doing.

SENATOR MOORE: Your intent is not for them to accelerate that.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Right. Right, and there is nothing in the bill that requires them to accelerate it. It simply...the intent is that they're doing it each year and it's the intent they continue to do that.

SENATOR MOORE: And it's not your intent for them to accelerate that, one; two, to come in and ask for additional money to fully get their 85 percent by the active date; three, eliminate any other programs that makes this a higher priority than ours.
