SENATOR ASHFORD: That's correct.

SENATOR MOORE: ...continue those that are now doing it at the same rate they're now doing it.

SENATOR ASHFORD: That's correct. I mean, they may speed up or slow down or whatever but generally they're to continue to do it at the level they're doing it now with some...and the hope is by 1995 that they will be completed. We just don't know at this point whether that's true, can be done.

SENATOR MOORE: Okay, thank you very much, Senator Ashford.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Does anyone else wish to speak on the bill? Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: On the bill or on the amendment, Madam President?

PRESIDENT MOUL: I'm sorry, on the amendment.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Okay.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Would you like to close, Senator Ashford?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes, thank you, Madam President. I would just urge that we move the amendment. It's again a technical amendment that coordinates LB 801 and 355, makes them...the provisions that were somewhat inconsistent, consistent. And I would urge its adoption.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Ashford. We will now vote on the Ashford amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Ashford's and Schellpeper's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Moore. Senator, your AM2202.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.
