I don't want to take any more time. It's a small matter for the law at large, it's a big matter for one individual, I hope you'll give him consideration. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. We will now vote on the Beutler amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Beutler amendment? Have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I guess I would ask for a call of the house and take call in votes, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays, to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. Would the senators please be seated and please check in. We are accepting call in votes on the Beutler amendment. The house is under call. Senator Ashford, Senator Pirsch, Senator Schellpeper, please check in. Senator Smith, please check in. Senator Schimek, please check in. Senator Coordsen, please check in. Okay. We are looking for Senators Pirsch, Ashford, and Coordsen. And we are accepting call in votes on the Beutler amendment. Now have a request for a roll call. Still looking for Senator Ashford. Senator Beutler, Senator Ashford is on his way, would you like to proceed? Senator Pirsch, would you please check in. We'll proceed with a roll call vote on the Beutler amendment. (Gavel.)

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2802 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 9 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. And I will raise the call.
