LB 617, 619

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion I have is to return Legislative Bill 619 to Select File for a specific amendment by Senator Conway. Senator, I have AM2259 in front of me. (See AM2259 on pages 2806-07 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. LB 619, which is the Board of Education, is following exactly the same district lines as the Board of Regents, which we just adopted those changes, so if you were to compare these...if you were to compare these you would see that they are exactly the same amendments addressing these technical errors between the Board of Regents and the Board of Education, so I simply request that we return to apply the same technical amendments to 619 as we just did to 617.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone wish to speak to this motion? Seeing none, we'll now vote on the motion to return 619. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Motion is adopted and we are now on Select. Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: As I mentioned in the request to bring it...to return it, I would appreciate the body adopting those technical amendments to the Board of Regents on LB 6...excuse me, the Board of Education just like we did on the Board of Regents under 617. We're now dealing with 619.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Conway amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Conway amendment? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will.
