

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is adopted. We are at Select File on 616, Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. LB 616, again, is the judicial district. All it is, it's a technical amendment in that Pacific doesn't go through and we've got to describe it as the lines that go around the little park. So I offer that to the body for the purpose of making this technical amendment to make it perfectly accurate as we are turning the maps into the language that describe it. So, with that, I hope that the body will adopt this amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Conway amendment to 616. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the readvancement of LB 616 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Heard the motion to readvance. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 616 is readvanced.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Withem would move to return LB 615 to Select File for specific amendment. Senator, I have your AM2247 in front of me. (See AM2247 on page 2808 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Madam Chair and members of the body, I'm once again offering an amendment that I think there was a 20/20 vote on on Select File. A number of people were gone. I don't want to take a lot of time with it. Nothing has changed particularly. Some one minor detail I'll talk about a little later on. My plan is still as it was. Unlike the Conway plan, which takes a portion of Gage County and Saline into the 3rd District, my plan leaves Saline and Gage in the 1st District. Unlike the Schimek plan, which would have taken Madison County
