PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hefner. Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Call the question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Do we have sufficient seconds? We do. We'll vote on the motion to cease debate. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to cease debate.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Debate has ceased. Senator Peterson for closing.

SENATOR PETERSON: Madam President, very few words. Tilden has been in the 1st District on the county line for as many years as I can remember, and this keeps all counties whole, does not split any county under the Withem amendment. I ask for your adoption. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Peterson. We'll now vote on the Peterson amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the Select File amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Peterson amendment is adopted. Need a motion to readvance. Senator Peterson.

SENATOR PETERSON: I move the advancement of my amendment to 615. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to readvance. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 615 is readvanced. Proceed with LB 614.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Conway would move to return LB 614 to Select File for a specific amendment. Senator, I have your AM2285 in front of me.
