SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall, would you take that motion for me, please?

SENATOR HALL: I would be happy to, Mr. Speaker. Would you like to have it withdrawn? You'd like to take it up? Let's kill the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the motion to indefinitely postpone LB 413A? We will now vote on that motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on a motion to indefinitely postpone 413A.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is indefinitely postponed. We will now go to LB 813.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 813, I have E & R amendments, first of all, Senator Will.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 813.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 813. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted. Next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments that I understand are to be withdrawn. Senator Conway has the first amendment. (See AM1640 found on page 2027 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Conway. Senator Beutler, are you going to handle that amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, it was a joint amendment by Senator Conway and myself and we wish to withdraw it. However, I wish to indicate, and I assume this is AM1578, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir, this is AM1640.
