

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, that will be withdrawn.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn. Next item.

CLERK: The next amendment I have, Mr. President, is by Senator Morrissey. (See AM1995 as found on page 2374 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Yes, Mr. President and members, thank you. This was simply a technical amendment on what I feel is a very important landfill siting bill that we need to get on with this year. My amendment was, again, technical. It would clearly state the legislative intent that cities have the ability to own and operate the regional landfills. We have found in the state plan, through our debate here, we have cities doing it now, Beatrice for one. Nebraska City is looking at that. It is the intent of the Legislature that the cities have that ability to run regional landfills and I'll come back with that next year. And I'd like you to...request that you withdraw both of those amendments, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler, your next amendment, Senator, AM1638.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, these are strictly technical amendments and I wish to withdraw them.

SPEAKER BAACK: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Morrissey, AM2030.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Was that my sub...the one I was substituting for the original one, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Well, this is the second one, so I assume this is the one you were substituting.
