LB 167, 297, 297A

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2815 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 24 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails. Would the senators please be seated so we can proceed with reading. Senator Pirsch, would you please be seated so we can proceed with Final Reading. We're on Final Reading. Would the senators please be seated. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 297 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 297 pass with the emergency clause? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2816 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 12 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 297 passes with the emergency clause. LB 297A.

CLERK: (Read LB 297A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 297A pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2816-17 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 11 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 297A passes with the emergency clause. LB 167.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Kristensen would move to return LB 167 to Select File for a specific amendment. (See page 2686 of the Legislative Journal.)
