

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of LR 198.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LR 198 is adopted. LR 199.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 199 introduced by Senator Abboud, on page 2620. (Read brief explanation.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Madam President and colleagues, the Ralston High School Baseball Team won the 1991 Class A High School Baseball Championship on May 17th of this year. They compiled a 16 to 2 record, and, more importantly, they've won this Class A High School Baseball Championship for a number of years recently. They won it in 1986, 1987, and 1988. CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of LR 199.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LR 199 is adopted. Proceed with LR 201.

CLERK: LR 201, Madam President, introduced by the Appropriations Committee and signed by its members. (Read brief explanation. See pages 2672-73 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, the Clerk has very accurately mentioned several dollars. This is some not really big cheeseburgers, but a certain dollar amount.
