Lindsay, Senator Chambers, Hall, Schrock, and Morrissey. Senator Lindsay, would you check in, please? We are looking for Senator Chambers. Senator Ashford. Proceed with the vote on the motion to reconsider. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: A roll call, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a roll call vote. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2851 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 20 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails. Further motions on the desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We'll proceed with LB 795.

CLERK: (Read LB 795 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 795 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: I'd like to ask us to check in and take a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Would the senators please check in. We are on Final Reading and the house is under call. Senator Lynch, Senator Lamb, Senator Lowell Johnson, Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Kristensen, Senator Wickersham, Senator Schmit, Senator Rasmussen, Senator Beutler, Senator Ashford, Senator Nelson, please check in. Senator Nelson, and Senator Schmit, please check in. We have a request for a roll call vote. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2852-53 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 10 nays, Madam President.
