

LR 186CA.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Schmit would move to return LR 186CA to Select File for specific amendment. Senator, I have your AM2301 in front of me. (Schmit amendment appears on pages 2853-55 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you, Mr. President, Mr. Clerk and Madam President. I do not want to take a lot of time and burden the Legislature, because I know we are short of time. I do want to ask that each of you read, if you have not done so, very carefully, the material that I passed out to you this morning relative to the fact that the United States Supreme Court has agreed to hear a case in the State of California versus...between Macy Department Store and Contra Costa County, which I believe will impact severely upon what we are doing here in this state. I believe it means that we should not pass LB 186 (sic) at this time. Mr. President, with that, I ask permission to withdraw the motion.

SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the resolution, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: You may read the resolution.

CLERK: (LR 186 read on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 186 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2858-59 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 10 nays, 4 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 186 does not pass with the necessary 40 votes.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a priority motion. Senators Baack and Hall would move to bracket LR 186CA until Wednesday, June 5.
