SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lamb, would you respond, please?

SENATOR LAMB: ..this year, this year, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: This year, and then the bill will be passed over or bracketed till next year?

SENATOR LAMB: Well, I don't have to do a thing. You know, at the stage we are now, it's not going to come up...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes. Okay.

SENATOR LAMB: ..for...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 783, LB 795, LB 67, LB 67A, and LB 625. Any further discussion on the motion to suspend the rules? Seeing none, Senator Lamb, did you wish to close?

SENATOR LAMB: Just hope that I can get the 30 votes here to suspend the rules so that we can proceed as has been outlined.
