They didn't send me down here to come as though I have to put a tin cup or my hat in hand and beg and say that what is being done in our community is some kind of charity when the hundreds of millions of dollars, the billions being spent by the budget of this state is going, Senator Lamb, to your people, not mine, and everybody on this floor knows it. I ask that you vote to override the Governor's veto. This money is not in the form of grants, and if Senator Lamb knew the kind of security that is asked for from some of these people seeking these loans it would stun him. One example, where people put 50,000 dollars of their own money into it, they put their houses up, they had enough to more than cover the amount that they were seeking in the loan and it was not on converting something to scrap and hoping a market is there to sell it. They were assets that could be liquidated overnight, and they still are having trouble getting favorable consideration. And I doubt that there is any screening process in this state that would be that type on anybody of your complexion on the floor of this Legislature, so the situations are not the same. Senator Moore has his comments. He says the Legislature's not turning its back on North Omaha. I can't do anything to change his mind, but I bet I've spent more time in the area where Senator Moore lives talking to his students, assisting his farmers, than he has ever spent in mine for any purpose. So if the day comes when we want to make a comparison, we can do it, but I hope that is not done at this particular time. I need 29 votes in addition to mine and I hope that they are here.
