

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is adopted. Do you have further motion?

CLERK: Madam President, I have a priority motion. Senator Warner would move to reconsider the motion to return LR 186CA to Select File for consideration of the Lindsay amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, I would withdraw that at this time.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is withdrawn. We will now proceed to vote. The question is, shall LR 186 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2939 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 12 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The resolution fails for consideration of a special election.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Withem would move to bracket LR 186 until Monday, June 10, 1991.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I filed this motion up there. I don't think anybody wants to pass LR 186 with a provision that it goes on the ballot for election at the next General Election. That would be the next vote that we would take. For that reason, I am starting asking unanimous consent to bracket LR 186.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I object.

PRESIDENT MOUL: There is an objection. Okay, Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yeah, I guess I don't care if people want to vote on this to put this on the General Election ballot so I withdraw the motion.
