

selling it outside of the fairgrounds at the present time. Now, we're...had a problem with Douglas County moving their fairgrounds into Ak-Sar-Ben. This is just one instance where there are some establishments right on the outside of Ak-Sar-Ben. And if we didn't change it, they wouldn't be able to operate during the Douglas County Fair. So, rather than do that for just one county, and we have some other counties that have also moved their fairgrounds recently, so we thought we'd just as well clean it up for every county so that if you have this establishment there, you can still operate. You're not on the actual county fairgrounds. But you can still operate during this county fair. So I th...and it's the same way with any keno, like I explained. If you are there, and it's your...if your community has it, you don't have to have it at your county fair. But if they wanted to, if they wanted to raise a little extra funds, they could do this through their local community. So what we're doing to help one or two counties, we thought we'd just as well do it for every county and make it fair for everyone. And that's why we have the amendment. Thank you.
