you'd have two million, one. Then you take from that the 300,000 that has been appropriated, you take from that the appropriation for the community techs, and whatever that balance, I think the figures that I have here say there would be \$1,151,000 in the account at the end of '93, and then that \$151,000 would be lapsed over, and everything depends upon how much money is appropriated from the contingency fund by the Appropriations Committee as to whether, in fact, there would be a lapse at the end of the fiscal year.

SENATOR ROBINSON: You mentioned the 300,000, is that what...

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...the department (interruption) agency itself.

SENATOR COORDSEN: They asked for \$300,000; traditionally spend about 150. This year I think they plan on spending the whole 300.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak to this bill? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Coordsen?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Only to encourage the advancement of the bill to Select. Thank you, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 562. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance LB 562.
