

January 13, 1992 LB 862, 863, 864

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 862 is advanced. LB 863.

CLERK: 863, introduced by Senator Warner as Chair of the board. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 8, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 873 (sic) would repeal an obsolete section of Community Health Outpatient Clinic Services. The particular section was obsolete, as a practical matter, two years from April 16, 1974 and this transitional provision which was passed in '74 has now been implemented in the sections obsolete. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there anyone who wishes to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 863. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 863.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 863 is advanced. LB 864.

CLERK: 864, introduced by Senator Warner. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 8, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this bill as indicated by its title repeal two obsolete sections relating to the railroad car and car company personal property tax reimbursement funds. The sections directed the distribution to be made upon August 31, 1988 to various political subdivisions. The dates obviously have passed and these sections are now obsolete. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 864. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
