

January 13, 1992 LB 864, 865, 866

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 864.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 864 is advanced. LB 865.

CLERK: 865, introduced by Senator Warner as Chair of the board. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 8 and referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 865 repeals an obsolete section relating to an interim study of the Education Committee. The study was mandated to be completed before January 1 of 1990. Again, obviously that date has passed and the section is obsolete. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 865. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 865.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 865 is advanced. LB 866.

CLERK: 866 was a bill introduced by Senator Warner as chairperson of the Executive Board. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 8 and referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 866 contains a reference to Section 86-317 to 86-327. These sections were repealed in 1963 and Sections 75-7709 to 75-0724 were adopted in 1963 in place of those. This bill would substitute the correct references. This is one of the revisor bills that a couple of people have called. I'm assuming there was something else I guess than what they actually do. I believe those misunderstandings are corrected, but in any event, this is the citation of the correct sections as a result of the laws that were enacted in 1963.
