

January 13, 1992 LB 866, 867, 868

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 866. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 866.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 866 is advanced. LB 867.

CLERK: 867, Madam President, is by Senator Warner as Chair of the Executive Board. (Title read.) Introduced on January 8 and referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 867 repeals two obsolete sections relating to appropriations. Section 90-501 and 90-502 were appropriation sections for the fiscal years '89-90 and '90-91. Obviously these two fiscal years have passed and these sections now are obsolete and no longer needed. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 867. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 867.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 867 is advanced. LB 868.

CLERK: 868, introduced by Senator Warner as Chair of the board. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 8 of this year, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, a section contains a reference to Section 32-498 which was repealed in 1975 and LB 453 in 1975 said to put in a new section as to how tie votes would be covered and the bill then would substitute the correct reference for the one which was repealed.
