CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance LB 312.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 312 is advanced. We will now proceed with bill introduction.

CLERK: Madam President, new bills. (Read by title for first time, LBs 1036-1047. See pages 247-49 of the Journal.) In addition to those items, Madam President, I have a hearing notice from the Urban Affairs Committee. It's signed by Senator Hartnett as chair of the committee. I have a report of registered lobbyists for the time frame starting with the beginning of session, or starting with actually July 19 through Friday, January 10. It's required by statute; a series of adds, Senator Crosby, to LB 470; Senator Baack to LB 943; Senator Lowell Johnson to LB 943; Senator Conway to LB 872; Senator Robak to LB 942; Senator Nelson, LB 872; Senator Labeledz, LB 872; Senator Coordsen, LB 872; Senator Lowell Johnson to LB 1013; Senator Wickersham to LB 894. Senator Will would like to withdraw his name as cointroducer to LB 327; Senator Ashford would like to withdraw his name as cointroducer to LB 327. And last item, Madam President, reminder the Reference Committee will meet upon recess in Room 2102 for referencing, Reference Committee, Room 2102 for referencing upon recess. That's all that I have.
