

I...I believe, we couldn't do that. It...it sort of restricts our ability to start...ship resources within the state because of definition. And that's a simple problem to alleviate. But we have to be very careful. Some other considerations, we brought this bill originally, or Senator Lamb brought it because the Department of Environmental Control said they had no ability to do much to these people that brought waste in from out-of-state. The waste was brought in and the Department asked who...where'd it come from. And they said, well, we don't think we're going to tell you. And that made a lot of people mad and rightfully so. And the Department said that they didn't think they had that ability. But I think that if you read these regulations, existing language that's contained in the amendment 2326...

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: ...you will find out that the department basically has the power to do whatever they need to protect the environment. It's fairly broad language in there. So I'm confused as to what our past director has stated, and I'm not sure that our present director agrees with that. Another thing is I believe because of certain definitions we are lic...giving the...the Department the authority to license recycling or processing facilities and I don't think they want that ability or think they need it. They want the ability to determine what is a recycling facility, but not necessarily a licensed one. So I guess all in all, I think we need to move this bill and look at some of the problems and as with the previous bill, possibly look at having it around to address solid waste in the state this year, in case we should run out of time a little later on, because we...I believe the solid waste bill that will result from the...
