this. And when you bring in volunteers and clergy, I think that is very relevant. I want to say one thing, Senator Dierks, I think you know me better. I don't take on things like this as a form of harassment. That's not my style and when they asked me to do this a year ago, I looked at it very carefully before I said I would file the amendments so I did file the amendments, but I have one question of you. Would you answer one question for me, "Cap"?

SENATOR DIERKS: Certainly.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay. Do you know whether the patrol, the state patrol or the Department of Education actually has the ability to do this kind of thing right now in a timely way?

SENATOR DIERKS: It is my information that the highway patrol has that ability. We were talking about this with gun control, if you recall, but like I said before, even though they have that ability it isn't something that has to be done immediately before the employment can start. Employment can be done on a provisional basis.

SENATOR CROSBY: But one of the things that is included in here, if I remember correctly, I was going to look before I started asking my question, is the possibility of fingerprinting, right?

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes, that's...(interruption)

SENATOR CROSBY: I think Senator Bernard-Stevens...we don't have. The fingerprinting system in Nebraska is antiquated, doesn't work very quickly so, from that point of view, I don't think that the patrol does have that ability. So...thank you, "Cap".

SENATOR DIERKS: Certainly.

SENATOR CROSBY: I just wanted to see how you would react to that because, there again, I agree with Senator Ashford that we're going to start a new bureaucracy, a lot more money for the Department of Education and again, as I said before, we are singling out really one group of people to do this to. And I know that teachers are the ones who are with the children probably more than anyone but not in intimate situations as the ones that I name are. And I think that the volunteers were a very good point for Senator Bohlke to bring up and her
