**PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING**

**PRESIDENT MOUL:** Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chambers. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Abigail Wilson Brown, from Northeast Community United Church of Christ in Lincoln. Pastor Brown.
