

January 15, 1992 LB 522, 529

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll proceed with introduction of new bills. There are no new bills. Since LR 220 has been referred to committee, we will proceed then with General File. LB 522 and...

CLERK: Madam President, 522 was discussed yesterday by the Legislature. At that time, certain amendments were offered, committee amendments were adopted. The next motion I have on the bill is that LB 522 be indefinitely postponed. It's offered by Senator Kristensen. Senator Dierks would have the option to lay the bill over, if he were so inclined. Senator Dierks indicates, Madam President, he'd like to lay the bill over.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 522 is laid over. We will then proceed with LB 529.

CLERK: Madam President, 529 was a bill introduced by Senator John Lindsay. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22 of this year and referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Lindsay, did you...

SENATOR LINDSAY: I don't believe, Madam President, I don't believe Senator Hall is here, but I can handle the amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: The committee amendments, members of the body, simply...the Revenue Committee reduced the tax rate and provided for withholding, did some technical things that Revenue Committee generally does with bills, and in addition to that did reduce the tax rate. I have no objection to the committee amendments, and I would urge that they be adopted.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Is there anyone who wishes to address the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to adopt the committee amendments. Since the machine is not working, we will have to do a roll call vote on these.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken.) 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of committee amendments.
